

#### IV. New Business

- A. Motion Unanimously Approved: The Green Team votes to recommend that the SORONC Board write a Community Impact Statement in support of Motion 14-0907: This motion requests that City departments and bureaus, the DWP, LAX, and the Port of Los Angeles take actions to reduce greenhouse gas emissions to at least 80% below 1990 levels by the year 2050 and that the Department of Water and Power reduce greenhouse gas emissions 80% below 1990 levels by 2030.
- B. New Year Plans: Discussion around leadership and what the community would like to see the SORONC GT work on as we start a new fiscal year.





- a. Potentially plan something akin to the H20 Town Hall but with a focus on Energy Conservation
- b. Rooftop solar federal rebates end in 2016 look into group discounts on community purchase
- c. Approaching businesses and schools about energy conservation projects, including white roofs
- d. Backyard composting classes for reducing methane
- e. New tree giveaways and tree planting
