

Green Team Committee Minutes

I. Call to Order and Roll Call

III. Old Business:

a. The entire meeting was spent reviewing Terrence Gomes' "Motion to Support the Suspension and re-evaluation of the DWP's FiT-100 Program" as requested by the South Robertson Neighborhoods Council Board. The committee members reviewed all documents submitted by those on both sides of the issue. Members of the community were invited to contribute additional comments should the committee be missing any important points. At the end of the hour, the committee voted unanimously against the motion to suspend the FiT 100 Program as currently structured and instead propose the following motion:

"That the South Robertson Neighborhoods Council support continuing the DWP's FiT 100 Program as currently structured."

Vote: 6 against suspending the FiT 100 Program; 0 for suspending the FiT 100 Program.

b. Paula Waxman reported that the Board DID NOT support the Green Team Committee's amendment to the motion,"to align NC efforts and funding towards the revitalization of South Robertson". The amendment was as follows:

"That the Board must develop a specific and budgeted action plan with timeline, that is approved by the Board no later than October 2013 Board meeting. Otherwise the funds should be allocated back to the committees or general fund for use in various community programs."
