 - a. **Tonight's Speaker-Anna Cummins**: Our oceans are becoming trashed with plastic waste. In 2007 Anna joined the Algalita Marine Research Foundation. She completed a 4,000-mile research expedition studying plastic debris in the North Pacific Gyre and a 2,000 mile speaking tour from Vancouver to Mexico on plastic pollution. Anna and Dr. Marcus Eriksen co-founded 5 *Gyres*, in collaboration with Algalita and Pangaea Explorations, to research and communicate plastic pollution in the worlds oceans. Learn about their findings, and hear her suggestions on solving this growing environmental threat.

Anna Cummins has over 10 years of experience in environmental work. She received her undergraduate degree from Stanford University, and her masters in International Environmental Policy from the Monterey Institute for International Studies. In 2001, she received a fellowship from the Sustainable Communities Leadership Program to work with Santa Cruz based non-profit Save Our Shores, coordinating bilingual outreach education and community relations. In 2007 she joined the Agalita Marine Research Foundation. She was elected a National Fellow of the Explorers Club in 2010.
