Council File 21-0002-S70 (Idaho Stop)

We, the South Robertson Neighborhoods Council, support the City Council motion to support AB 122 (Safety Stop Bill) which would amend California Vehicle Code section 22450 to allow bicycle riders to treat stop signs as yields.

Council File 21-0002-S75 (e-bikes)

We, the South Robertson Neighborhoods Council, support the City Council motion to support H.R. 1019 (Electric Bicycle Incentive Kickstart for the Environment Act) and AB 117 (Electric Bicycle Rebate Pilot Project). Electric bikes reduce the physical effort required to ride a bike and allow more people to ride bikes for longer trips.

Metro File 2020-0595 (BRT)

We, the South Robertson Neighborhoods Council, support efforts to install BRT on LaCienega Blvd, a major bus corridor. BRT on this section of LaCienega would allow for fast and convenient access between the Expo Line and future Purple Line stations, incentivizing residents to use public transportation.

Council File 21-0350 (supportive housing)

We, the South Robertson Neighborhoods Council, support this motion's efforts to expand permanent supportive housing on the Westside. As research shows, permanent supportive housing is the only scientifically-backed solution to ending homelessness. Additionally, we ask our own Councilmembers Koretz and Ridley-Thomas to support similar efforts in CD 5 and 10.

Council File 21-0035 (RSO replacement)

We, the South Robertson Neighborhoods Council, support this motion to adopt an ordinance that mandates one-for-one replacement of rent-stabilized units citywide. There is currently no strong uniform requirement for one-for-one replacement of RSO units anywhere in Los Angeles.
