#### IV. New Business

- a. Discussion and possible action on The Department of City Planning, with assistance from the Department of Building and Safety, has prepared proposed amendments to the regulations established by the Baseline Mansionization Ordinance (BMO) and the Baseline Hillside Ordinance (BHO). This is in response to motion CF 14-0656 requesting the Department address concerns regarding out-of-scale development in single-family neighborhoods. The amendments apply to property zoned R1, RS, RE, or RA in the Hillside Area and non-Hillside Area (outside of the Coastal Zone). The ordinance reduces the allowable base FAR, reduces the number and amount of FAR bonus options, and modifies FAR exemptions. Attached is a Q&A sheet that explains the changes and outlines next steps. Dates on the staff public hearings will follow shortly.
