

- A. CUP ZA-2011-1896-CU additional storage building 2251 sq ft. to a 3 lot parcel located at 8661 W. Pico Bl. Los Angeles, CA 90035. The proposed project includes the demolition of an exiting out of code building and replacing it by a one story auto parts storage facility in addition to an existing auto repair facility (Independent Motorcare Clinic, Inc.) The applicant is applying for a CUP to bring the building up to code and to keep the existing sign which is not code compliant. The committee was interested in having the owner provide proof that they notified the effected neighbors and provide feedback from them. Due to timing the LUED committee asked David Giron to help facilitate a 30 day extension with the ZA and to send the motion to the full Board without a recommendation.
