## **IV. New Business**

### 2012 Election Update.

All requested information has been submitted to the Department of Neighborhood Empowerment's election team. After discussion, the Committee felt that Shenandoah would be the best location for the election (reach into the community, ease of parking, already a known polling location, etc.). Martin is following through to find a contact there. Martin suggested that we conduct bus tours of the neighborhood in advance of the candidate filing date. Doug said he would update the website with current information. Election Committee will hold a join meeting with Outreach to kick off activity in July.

### Westside Regional Alliance of Councils Update.

A recommendation on the Community Care Ordinance will coming before the Board soon, probably in August. WRAC is prepping motions on Casden and Bergamot Station development projects. It is unlikely that WRAC will co-ordinate regional election outreach.

### Discussion of July Board agenda.

The bulk of the meeting will be recognition of the Bursk Community Leadership award nominees. Mike Newhouse will speak on the relationship between SORO NC and WRAC. Betsy Butler, currently a candidate for the 50th State Assembly District, will speak during public comment. The Green Team has a motion on fracking. The Board will be asked to fill out surveys from the City Planning Dept.
