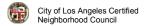

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General Board Meeting Minutes

Thursday, February 20, 2014, 7:00pm Simon Wiesenthal Center, 3rd Floor 1399 S. Roxbury Dr., Los Angeles, CA 90035 (Pico and Roxbury)

I. Call to Order & Roll Call

SORO Board President, Doug Fitzsimmons, called the meeting to order at 7:10 PM.

Board Members Present (19): Kevin Gres, Beth Ryan, Robyn Braun, Bette Billet, Michael Lynn, Jon Liberman, Ellen Lanet, Paula Waxman, Michoel Bloom, Nahed Guirguis, Brian Kite, Barry Levine, Susan Burden, Marj Safinia, Terrence Gomes, Martin Epstein, Victor Mitry, Doug Fitzsimmons, Grant Cohen.

Board Members Absent (5): Kimber Smith, Daniel Boethin, David Mattis, Jessica Kurzban and Sarah Sabin.

II. General Public Comment

- Marj Safinia shared that on March 1st there will be a full day of film screenings at the Writers Guild Theater. For more details, go to: Documentary.org/docuday
- b. Doug Fitzsimmons commented on the recent shootings in neighborhood and the increase in violence. He reported that the Worksmen's Circle mural was defaced two weeks ago.
- c. Terry Gomes and Jon Liberman will be recognized in city council for their work with the We Build program.

III. Community Reports

- a. LA Police Department (Senior Lead Officer Mario Gonzalez)
 - At 2812 S Robertson on February 17th in the morning, two hispanics were involved in an altercation with another victim. Also, Office Depot was burglarized during the night and Worksmens Circle mural was defaced.
 - 2000 Corning Street there was a shooting on February 19th. Four individuals were outside facing west bound. A car came Southbound from Guthrie and shot 9 rounds hitting two of the males. Both victims were transported to Cedars Sinai and required surgery. One man was 50-years old and the other victim was 30-years old. Neither victim saw anything and neither are involved in gang activity. A witness saw a dark colored 4-door VolksWagon.
 - Additional LAPD cars have been assigned to the community with the increase in activity.

b. Office of Mayor Garcetti (Daniel Tamm)

 Budget discussions have been taking place throughout the city over the past few weeks.

c. Office of Assemblymember Sebastian Ridley Thomas (Scott Maslin)

 Maslin recently was hired by Riddley Thomas. He was a former mayor of Culver City where he faced similar issues facing the westside and has a strong belief that Assemblymember Ridley-Thomas will be very active. Assemblymember Ridley Thomas will be attending our April 17th board meeting to meet everyone.





d. Office of Assemblymember Bloom (Stephanie Cohen)

- Assembly Bills introduced include:
 - AB1839 film tax credit incentive
 - AB1637 special driver's license for veterans
 - AB1535 medication given to parents to avoid overdoses
 - AB1699 plastic beads in face wash where animals are suffering the consequences.
 - There will be a homeless panel discussion in Pacific Palisades including LAPD, City Attorney, Assemblymembers and members of the City Council

IV. Presentation

 Proposed changes to Robertson Blvd to reduce cut-through neighborhood traffic/Pat Gibson, Gibson Transportation

Mr. Gibson explained the problem on Robertson Blvd. with the bottlenecks when someone attempts to turn left on Robertson between Cattaraugus and just north of Cadillac. There are roughly 1500-1600 cars traveling north each hour during morning travel hours with the same number traveling south each night. The increased traffic and bottlenecks have commuters cutting through the residential streets.

Mr. Gibson's proposal was to:

- Eliminate the ability to turn left during rush hours between Cattaraugus and just north of Cadillac
- Eliminate parking heading north in the morning to allow three lanes heading north when the traffic is heaviest
- Eliminate parking heading south in the evening to allow three lanes heading south when the traffic is heaviest
- Run bike lanes parallel to Robertson Blvd rather than on Robertson when traffic is heavy

Several members of the community spoke against the proposal indicating that it was short sighted and focused on cars more than pedestrians and that they did not support this proposal as the best way to reduce traffic on Robertson Blvd. They felt that once these "test" changes were implemented that the changes would become permanent.

 - Resignation of Hector Garza, Organization Rep 1 Hector has officially resigned from the board effective immediately.

 - SORO Neighborhood Council Election will be on Sunday, May 18th.

VII. New Business I

a. Motion to support proposed changes to Robertson Blvd. (Transportation/GB022014-1)

MOTION AND AMENDMENT: (amendment to motion in bold letters)

- I. That while the traffic caps on Motor Ave. continue to unacceptably compound the traffic problems on Robertson Blvd, destroying the business district and creating dangerous conditions within our residential areas, change by the City and LADOT is urgently needed;
- II. That SORO NC finds considerable merit in the proposed changes to Robertson Blvd with the aim of reducing the volume of commuter cut-through traffic in residential areas and increasing public safety and would like to therefore bring the discussion to the community.
- III. That the impact on businesses must be offset by the development by the City and/or third parties of off-street parking to serve the area between Cadillac and Cattaraugus.

AMENDMENT:

- Marj Safinia moved the amendment and it was seconded by Brian Kite
- Amendment was unanimously approved by general consensus (19 board members voting)

MOTION:

- Doug Fitzsimmons moved the motion and it was seconded by Jon Liberman
- Vote Count was: (15 YES/4 NO/0 Abstain)
- Motion was approved by the board

VIII. New Business II

- a. SORO Community Grant Applications (Grant Evaluation Committee)
 - . Fresh Fruit on Friday grant for \$3,669.30 (GB022014-11)
 - Motion was tabled by general consensus with 19 board members voting.
 - II. LAUSD We Build program grant for \$1950 (GB022014-12)

MOTION: South Robertson Neighborhoods Council will fund the NPG for \$1,950 for the LAUSD 13-week We Build Program to train 15 disadvantaged workers in the construction trade. The 15 spots will have priority for SORONC area residents, but will be filled with other qualified candidates in the bordering areas to fill the class with disadvantaged workers.

- Vote Count was: (17 YES/0 NO/0 Abstain)

MOTION: To approve \$1085.15 in funding for the Canfield South Neighborhood Butterfly Garden NPG

- Vote Count was: (17 YES/0 NO/0 Abstain)
- Motion was unanimously approved by the board
- IV. Canfield Elementary School outdoor garden classroom renewal for \$2,782.33 (GB022014-14)

MOTION: To approve \$2,782.33 in funding for the Canfield School Garden Outdoor Classroom NPG.

- Vote Count was: (15 YES/0 NO/2 Abstain)
- Motion was approved by the board
- b. Motion to fund \$800 for Town Hall on proposed changes to Robertson Blvd and revitalization efforts (Outreach/GB022014-6)

MOTION: That SORO NC \$800 of funding for costs associated with the production and outreach for SORO NC's 2014 Town Hall event.

- Vote Count was: (16 YES/1 NO/0 Abstain)
- Motion was approved by the board
- c. Motion to fund \$1000 for LAUSD School Board District One candidate forum (Education/GB022014-7)

MOTION: South Robertson Neighborhoods Council will fund up to \$1,000 for a candidate forum to fill the LAUSD Board seat in District One. The Town Hall style event will be held at Hamilton High School in the Auditorium on May 1, 2014 from 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM.

- Motion was approved by the board
- d. Motion to fund \$3,500 for 2014 SORO NC elections (Board Development/GB022014-8)

MOTION:

- I. To approve the 2014 Election budget of \$3,500 to be used for outreach for candidates and voters as well as for day-of-election costs.
- II. To increase the amound on the P-card expenditures for this quarter by \$3,500 to cover all expenses for the 2014 elections.

- Motion was approved by the board

e. Motion to fund \$395 for SORO NC street banner inspection and repair (Liberman/GB022014-9)

MOTION: The Outreach Committee seeks approval to hire AAA Flag & Banner to repair or remove the two banners that are not anchored, to do on site repairs on the remaining banners where possible and to produce an inventory of the status of the remaining banners. The cost will be \$395. Based on the inventory the Outreach Committee may have a future recommendation as to the remaining banners which would come before the Board for approval.

f. Motion to fund \$480/year for meeting location for Transportation Committee (Libermand/GB022014-10)

MOTION: That the SORO NC Board authorize the change of location for the Transportation Committee meetings. The cost of this change would be \$27.00/hour.

- Vote Count was: (7 YES/8 NO/2 Abstain)
- Motion was NOT approved by the board
