

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# Motion to reconsider the NC's opposition to the Century City Center based on proposed traffic mitigations

# **Full Proposal**

Proposed By:

JMB Realty's proposed Century City Center project at the corner of Avenue of the Stars and Constellation Boulevard would include a 37-story office building, a public plaza, a mobility hub, and a smaller, "loft-like" creative office space, all built to LEED Platinum standards. The project size and scope relies on the use of an "alternative calculation of trip generation factors"—in short, they argue that the building will generate less traffic than the 1982 Specific Plan predicts it will.

Nevertheless, SORO NC has expressed concerns about the impact the project would have on our already traffic-burdened neighborhoods. As a result, in April of 2013 the SORO NC Board formally approved the following:

That SORO NC opposes the development at Century City Center as presented, without the inclusion of specific mitigations and studies of the problems and concerns of our community and stakeholders, which we have voiced consistently.

SORO NC is very open to continued conversations with JMB Realty on these points, so that such agreements can be made in writing and included in the project's scope. Until such time, we strongly oppose this project.

In the ensuing months, we have continued to talk with JMB, Beverlywood Homes Association, and Council District 5 to develop a mitigation plan that would address the NC's concerns. JMB has conducted studies of Beverlywood and Robertson as requested, and has proposed a funded mitigation plan as part of its draft amended development agreement with the City.

# **Proposed Motion**

- To withdraw SORO NC's opposition to JMB Realty's Century City Center project contingent on the City's acceptance of the Obligations and Public Benefits section of the project's draft amended development agreement;
- II. To acknowledge the benefits of the project, including its much-needed job creation, its encouragement of alternative transportation and transit connections, and its adherence to rigorous LEED Platinum green building standards:
- To again urge the City Council to enact changes to the Century City North III. Specific Plan that would remove the ability for future development projects to propose alternative trip generation factors, and in the meantime to immediately adopt an interim control ordinance to suspend use of the Plan's Section 6 provisions within new project applications filed after April 17, 2014.





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

Unfortunately, the neighborhood purposes grant (NPG) passed by the NC in May lacked a Business Tax Registration Certificate (BTRC). Since the drop-dead deadline for NPG submissions was May 15, we do not have the ability to wait for a BTRC to be issued.

Any funding motion from this point until June 15<sup>th</sup> must be something we can put on the NC's purchase card. Several suggested options are listed below; the motion should be amended to choose one or more.

# **Proposed Motion**

- I. To reallocate \$2000 previously passed for the Castle Heights playground equipment NPG for:
  - Purchase of playground equipment by the NC directly, as detailed in the attached list
  - b. Funding of additional CPR sessions organized by the SORO NC Public Safety committee
  - c. Payment of recurring operations expenses
  - d. Contributing to the 2014 Neighborhood Council Congress
  - e. Contributing to the Neighborhood Council Budget Advocates
- II. To request an increase in our FY 2013-14 fourth quarter purchase card limit by an additional \$2000
