General Board Meeting Minutes

I. Call to Order & Roll Call

SORO Board President, Doug Fitzsimmons, called the meeting to order at 7:15 PM.

II. General Public Comment – no public in attendance

III. Community Reports

- a. Office of Assemblymember Bloom (Cohen)
 - Assemblymember Bloom is preparing his legislative packet including bills on early childhood education, tax credits, homelessness as well as pushing the bills that were approved for 2-years including the AB981 redevelopment bill as well as the smoking ban bill.
 - Assemblymember Bloom was recently added to the transportation policy committee in addition to being the chair of the budget subcommittee.
 - Doug asked Stephanie what Assemblymember Bloom's position was regarding medical marijuana dispensaries. Stephanie indicated that he is not willing to regulate to the cities regarding this issue. It was suggested that Doug send the Assemblymember a letter breaking down the issue and concerns of the community requesting support and a meeting.

V. Committee Reports


- a. Confirmation of Board committee memberships and absence requests (GB112113-3)

- b. President's report
 - Doug Fitzsimmons referred to the murder of the 7-year old in SORO. He encouraged everyone to attend the Public Safety Committee meeting on January 6th, 2014.
 - Westside Caregivers a medical marijuana dispensary discussed in detail at the Town Hall had a complaint filed against them. The arraignment was postponed.
 - JMB Project Doug has been attending meetings with the developer. Planning Commission will meet in early February as the first step in getting the project approved.

- c. Treasurer's report and approval of monthly expenses (Gomes/GB121913-
 - 4)
- Terrence Gomes explained that in addition to the monthly expenditures including storage, telephone, food etc that there was also a cost for security for the most recent Town Hall. Terry and Mike Lynn have been to City Hall to discuss the new checking account procedures starting in January. The limit for the debit card will be \$2500 and the ATM will not have a pin number.
 - a. Terrence Gomes moved the motion and it was seconded by Jon Liberman.
 - b. Vote Count was: (13 YES/0 NO/1 Abstain)
 - c. Motion was approved by the board.

VI. New Business

- a. Motion to urge that the City Council require net neutrality in its City-wide Broadband RFP (Fitzsimmons / GB112113-9)
 - The SORO board voted on this motion at November's meeting.
- b. Motion to support parking at Expo stops (Fitzsimmons / GB112113-11)

MOTION: The South Robertson Neighborhood Council requests that the Transit Neighborhood Plan being developed by the City of Los Angeles investigate and pursue incentives to develop devoted Expo Line rider parking as part of a redevelopment plan for the shopping center at 9860 National Blvd. (currently anchored by Vons) in a manner that would preserve the character and services in this development.

SORO NC further requests that the Transit Neighborhood Plan being developed by the City of Los Angeles investigate and pursue incentives to develop a vibrant pedestrian corridor connecting Palms Station with the Motor Avenue and National Blvd. intersection in Palms.

- a. Doug Fitzsimmons moved the motion and it was seconded by Kimber Smith.
- b. Motion was approved by general consensus. (15 board members voting)
- c. Motion to support LAX/Metro connection (Liberman / GB112113-12)

MOTION: Resolved, the South Robertson Neighborhoods Council supports a Metro rail station on the Crenshaw Line (that could also serve as an additional station for the Green Line) at the Intermodal Transit Facility (ITF) proposed for LAX.

Resolved further, the South Robertson Neighborhoods Council, asks that when the Metro rail station is being built the Contractor be asked to hire a minimum of twenty-five (25) residents of Soro to work on the construction.

Soro NC will partner with educational, Union and Construction Companies to train and equip these people. This will be done without expending NC funds.

- Jon Liberman moved the motion and it was seconded by Ellen Lanet.
- Vote Count was: (11 YES/5 NO/2 Abstain)
- Motion was approved by the board.

VII. New Business (20 minutes)

a. Motion to recognize School Board Member Marguerite LaMotte's service to the community (Liberman / GB121913-5)
