Re: Century City Neighborhood Traffic Management Plan

Dear ???:

I am writing on behalf of the South Robertson Neighborhoods Council ("SORO NC") to comment on the following issue.

LA DOT created The Century City Neighborhood Traffic Management Plan (CCNTMP) to provide a means of mitigating the peak hour traffic to and from Century City and through the surrounding neighborhoods.

One of the most effective traffic calming measures for Motor Avenue has been metering traffic at critical points along Motor to reduce the likelihood that drivers will choose Motor Avenue for their cut through driving. The plan successfully capped peak hour traffic down to 600 cars/hour. However, this has adversely increased cut through traffic in adjacent neighborhoods, especially on Beverwil and Beverly Dr., creating a nightmare for the residents of Beverlywood.

SORO NC would like to propose that LA DOT perform a reevaluation of the traffic limits on Motor Ave., in order to secure a more equitable level of neighborhood traffic distribution. Adjusting the cap (or other measures) could have a significant impact in distributing traffic more evenly throughout all of the neighborhoods.
