 - Mike: Want to be included in the initial process, not once they've decided. For things like street repairs, we should be alerted so we can tell the neighborhood. Input on major projects and info on minor repairs

ii. Mike moves to write the following letter to DoT, Metro, and Street Services:

They allow sufficient time in advance of major projects for the NC to provide input on the project, such as protected bike lanes, bus lanes and routes, and car lane expansion, as well as notification of all projects in the immediate future, such as resurfacing or street repairs, so the NC can notify stakeholders.
