Dear Chairperson Carrillo and Committee Members,

The South Robertson Neighborhoods Council, voted (Vote count) on April 17, 2025 to support Assembly Bill 467 (Fong) which would extend for five years the ability of Neighborhood Councils to have an option to meet virtually, if desired.

The South Robertson Neighborhoods Council recommends the bill be amended to change the existing virtual attendance requirement from within the **City** of Los Angeles to instead allow for attendance from "within the **County** of Los Angeles." We also recommend that the required two-thirds Neighborhood Council vote to opt in to meeting virtually be clarified to **two-thirds of the members present and voting** to do so.
